

Viveka Larsson



Viveka Larsson is the District Governor Elect for District 2330 in Sweden.

She graduated as a veterinarian in 1978 and has worked with several different areas of veterinary medicine, both as a clinician and administratively. For the last 20 years she has worked for the Swedish Food Agency with food safety and food control. Viveka became a Rotarian in 1996, as one of the first women in her club. She was president 2000-01. In 2018 the two clubs in Bollnäs merged and Viveka became the

first president of the new club for 2018-19.

Viveka's husband Olof preceded her as a Rotarian. He joined Rotary in 1988 and was the president of his club in 1995-96 and has since served actively in many club roles. He is also a veterinarian and has worked mainly with farm animals. He retired a few years ago to have more time for gardening, hunting and fishing.

Viveka and Olof live in the countryside outside the small town of Bollnäs, about 300 kilometers (180 miles) north of the Swedish capital, Stockholm. The household also includes a dog and four cats. They have two sons and one daughter, all adults aged 30 to 36.
